

Axiom Ltd. **Presents** The Uniform Axiom 25[™] Caulk Line

Items Required:

· Square Laminate Chips with • Axiom 25TM Translucent One Corner Rounded over Silicone

· Caulk Gun · Spray Bottle containing **Denatured Alcohol**


Step #1:

Take a laminate chip with square corners and round over one corner to the desired size of the cove you want to create in the caulk. (Have several handy.)

Step #2:

Start with a clean edge or seam. Using Axiom 25[™] translucent silicone, caulk your edge to the smallest bead desired.

· Rags and/or Paper Towels



Step #3:


Spray caulk line with denatured alcohol. (This will slow the curing process of the silicone and keep excess silicone from adhering to other areas of the material.)

Step #4:

Take a rag or paper towel in one hand and hold the laminate chip in the other. Place the rounded corner in the caulk having the straight sides of the laminate chip against the back and base of countertop.

Step #5:

Pull the laminate chip along the caulk line in one direction. At 6" - 10" or when excess caulk builds up on chip, whip excess off into rag or paper towel.



Step #6:

Continue process starting $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 1" behind where you left off until finished.

Results:

A uniform caulk line with no mess.
