The downturn in the economy has placed obstacle after obstacle in my path continually questioning my trust in the Lord and His plan for me. I have gotten involved in more at church and I have left a comfortable seat in the "audience ministry" and moved forward to more meaningful things. During a Sunday Life Group my heart was touched when I was introduced to a ministry in Haiti, one of the poorest countries in the world. Now some of you may have heard me spouting off about all our efforts overseas while we have homeless in our own backyard but I was absolutely amazed at the realization that these people have almost nothing. The idea that 20 US dollars could stop a child from going to bed hungry just blew me away, so much so that I felt compelled to pass the news of this ministry on to you.

The Grace for Glory Ministry was started and is administered by one of our church members Kathy Cope. Kathy has dedicated her time, her money and her heart to helping the children of the El Shaddai Home in Haiti. The home houses 22 children and 8 staff members. Many of the children are orphaned but many were simply abandoned on the streets of Haiti. Shortly after the home was started the El Shaddai Christian School was formed. In 2007 70 children attended the school, children who just a year before we roaming the streets. The school helps over 100 children now.

I have made a conscious decision to do what I can to help these children in any way I can and I urge you to do the same.
